The historic house is situated on Walnut Street, near 69th Street on land owned by St. Alice's Parish and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The plans are to obtain a long-term lease and to restore the oldest part of the house for use in teaching local history and to modernize a newer section for multi-purpose use by the parish and the community.
