GLENOLDEN – Cashin Homestead on Chester Pike Sold for More Than \$100,000

One of the biggest real estate deals which Glenolden has witnessed in some time was announced yesterday, that of the sale of the remainder of the old James J. Cashin farm at the northwest corner of Chester Pike and Oak Lane. The property was sold by W. M. Hawthorne to an undisclosed purchaser for a price named in excess of \$100,000. Lately it has been owned and occupied by Samuel Sloan.

The tract consists of an old farm house, a frontage of four hundred feet on Chester Pike and two hundred feet on Oak Lane, which is a new state highway to be paved with concrete next year. It is expected an operation of stores will be built on the tract.
