RUMORED NEW LINE FROM GARRETTFORD – Reported That the Garrettford Street Railway Company Will Erect A Road to Media

There are persistent rumors that the Philadelphia and Garrettford Street Railway Company is about to build and operate any other line from Garrettford to Media. There is certainly something in the report as the engineers of the company are busily engaged in surveying and staking out for a line from Garrettford, through Drexel Heights, Heyville, and then on to the Springfield Road towards Media. This is just what the farmers and others in Upper Darby have desired for some time, and it looks now as if their desires will be granted.

It has also been reported that the Company will erect a large power plant in Garrettford, where they have purchased an entire block on which there are a number of houses. The location would just be about right for a power station and, while none of the officials could be communicated with yesterday, there is every reason to believe that reports have some bearing on the matter.
