COUNTRY CLUB TO ENLARGE HOUSE – Springhaven Organization to Expend \$6000 or \$7000 for Improvements to the Handsome Property

The present cozy club house of the Springhaven Country Club, situated in the midst of a cluster of fine shade trees, is to be enlarged at an expense of \$6000 or \$7000. The subject has been under consideration for some time, but did not assume definite shape until the meeting on Friday night when it was given serious consideration. It was but a short time before almost enough funds had been subscribed for the project which is no necessary at present for the perfect accommodation of the popular organization and the numbers in the membership has made a large club house necessary. Only last week thirteen applications were received for membership. The club has become one of the most popular and sought after of any clubs in this section of the country. This is due not only to the beautiful location of the golf links and the club house, but also to the environments which surround the membership. The list of members contains the names of many of the best families of Delaware County.

To give the necessary room it is proposed to make an addition to the present structure on the east and south by 22 feet wide by 70 long. In this will be placed the locker room and wash room. The present locker room will be turned into a kitchen. This will allow a porch to be constructed along the entire length of the building 72 feet long and 22 feet wide for a part of the distance. The present porches will be turned into the main rooms of the present buildings. This will permit the enlargement of the dining room and things more pleasant for everyone. It will also give a main room on the second floor large enough for the events given exclusively by the ladies, which will be much appreciated by the fair sex.
