TWIN OAKS CAMP

It Closed This Morning After A Successful Meeting

The Woods Were Filled Yesterday With Earnest Men and Women – An Early Prayer Meeting This Morning

The attendance was quite large at Twin Oaks camp yesterday. After a very successful day on Saturday, when Rev. C. L. Hyde was the preacher, everybody appeared to be full of vigor and enthusiasm when the Sabbath dawned, and after the strangers began to arrive early in the morning, the camp was a scene of active life. At 6 o'clock there was a well-attended prayer meeting, and after breakfast the sacrament of Baptism was administered to five candidates making a total of seventeen baptized during the camp.

At 9 o'clock an experience meeting was held, and at 10 o'clock presiding elder L. F. Haas preached a powerful and effective sermon. At 2 o'clock p.m. another experience meeting was held. Rev. C. W. Ruth, of Indianapolis, was the preacher at 3 pm. Another experience meeting at 7 p.m. and an appropriate sermon at 8 p.m. by Rev. J. Trumbauer concluded yesterday. Amounted to nearly \$300 during the entire camp meeting. At 9:30 o'clock yesterday morning a free will offering was taken up on behalf of presiding elder L. F. Haas, when \$60 was realized.

This morning a prayer meeting was held at 6 o'clock, after which there was a general hand shaking, which concluded one of the most successful camp meetings ever held in this section by the Heavenly Recruits. Immediately after the conclusion, the operations were commenced on the taking down of the tents, and the removal of all the paraphernalia of the camp.

Rev. C. L. Hyde will hold another regular preaching service in Mt. Zion Church on Wednesday morning at 8 o'clock when a large attendance is desired.
