EDDYSTONE BOROUGH

The town of Eddystone was incorporated into a borough December 17, 1888, and the first election for borough officers was held February 19, 1889. It is the seat of The Eddystone Manufacturing Company (Ltd), and is located on the east side of Ridley Creek, the dividing line between the borough and the City of Chester, and extends to the west bank of Crum Creek, with the Delaware River as its southern and the Philadelphia Post Road as its northern boundary. The works of The Eddystone Manufacturing Company (Ltd), are very extensive, occupying twenty acres of ground, and consist of twenty separate buildings for bleaching, printing and dyeing cotton cloths. they have a capacity of 60,000,000 yards of finished goods per year. The number of hands employed is 700. The grounds around the works are beautifully laid out in a park and the main streets are lined with stately trees. The Company have erected a fine building called Lighthouse Hall, and supplied it with a good library, newspapers and periodicals for the use of the boroughites.
