LANSDOWNE TO HAVE A NEW TOWN HALL –Building That Will Cost \$12,000 to be Erected by the Borough Council

The borough of Lansdowne is to have a new Town Hall and fire house, to be erected at a cost of \$12,000.

At a meeting of the Borough Council last night an ordinance, incorporating an agreement between the Lansdowne Fire Company and the borough to build a modern structure in which will be located the Council Chamber and the fire company's headquarters, the fire company agreeing to convey its lot to the borough, with a provision to the effect that Council make an annual appropriation to the company, was adopted on third reading.

The Guarantee Trust and Safe Deposit Company of Philadelphia were awarded the contract to furnish the \$24,000 bonds, its bid being the highest submitted. The money will be used in the construction of the new Town Hall and in the improvement of streets.
